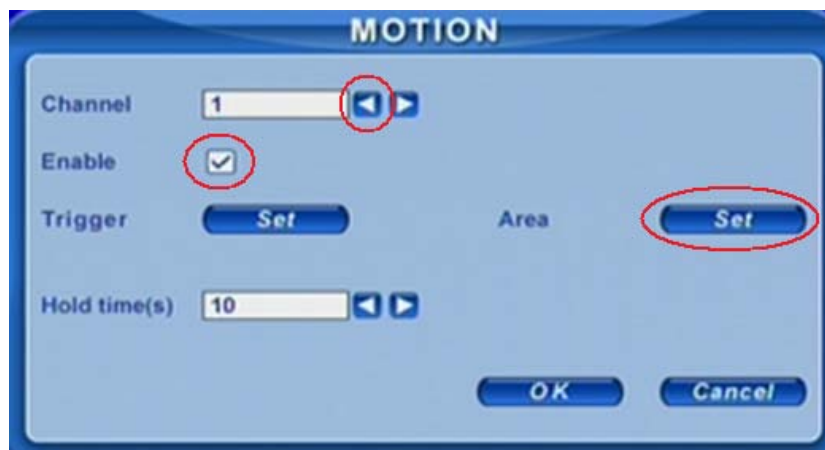


Motion Detection Recording

Note: **Disable** the manual record on the dvr **before** setting up motion configuration (press the record button – to turn off the green circle indicators).

- 1) Put a check in the enable box.
- 2) Click on Area Set.



- 3) Click on All.
- 4) Click on Save.

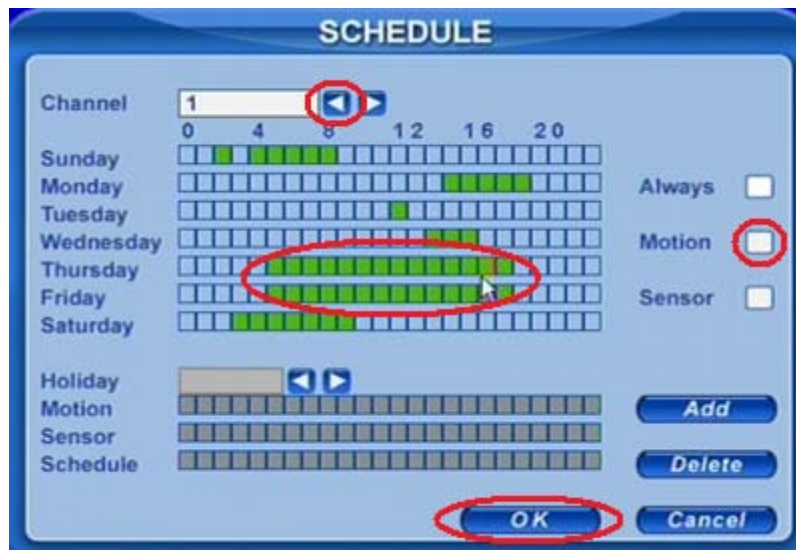


- 5) Change the Channel to Camera 2 & **repeat steps 1-4** until you finish all of the cameras.
- 6) When completed with configuring all the cameras, select ok to exit the Motion menu.

Note: You **must setup a schedule** – in order for Motion Recording to occur.

Setting up the Schedule to record Motion Detection Recording

- 1) Enter the Schedule menu.
- 2) Change the Channel to ALL .
- 3) Put a check in the Motion box.
- 4) Click on the hour boxes by turning them green & then, the dvr will record at the appropriate hour you selected.



- 5) Select OK to complete the schedule.
- 6) Exit out to the live cameras, you will see a yellow circle indicator appear on the camera channel that has motion.

Note: **Do not press the record button.** The motion recording will happen automatically.

Tips

- If the yellow circle indicator doesn't appear as often, when motion occurs, increase the Sensitivity for that particular camera.
- Also, decrease the Sensitivity if the camera is recording, when you feel it should not be.



- The light level is also a factor for the dvr to sense a change in activity.
- For example, at night when the light level drops and the dvr doesn't pick up the change in motion & isn't recording - switch to **record always** – during the night hours.
- That way you avoid the chance of missing a critical event.
