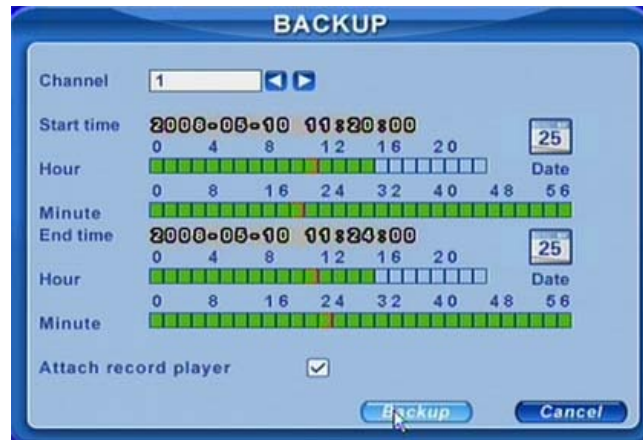


Backup & View

Format you USB flash drive to FAT32 on the computer – first.

Insert the USB flash drive in side of the dvr.

Push the backup button on the front panel of the dvr to enter the backup interface.



Choose the camera, click on the Date button on the right to change the date.

After the search pulls the video data, select the hour & minute – for both start time & end time.

Check mark the “Attach record player” option.

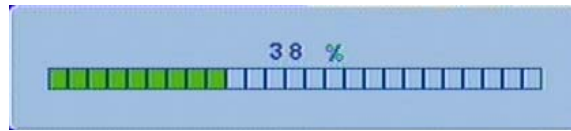
That will save a file player along with the backed up files.

With this player, users can playback the backup files on the USB flash drive.

Note: *If users install a DVD writer in the dvr, it will show CD-ROM in window even though users install DVD writer.*

Select the OK button.

It will begin to write the video files you selected to the backup device, and display a progress bar as shown below:



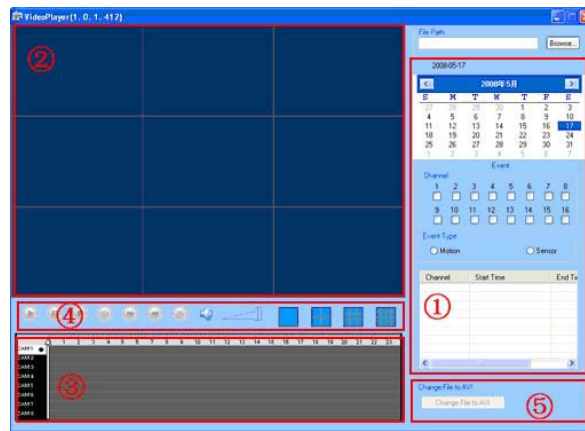
It will show "Backup complete" after finished, as shown below:



Playback the video file(s) from the USB:

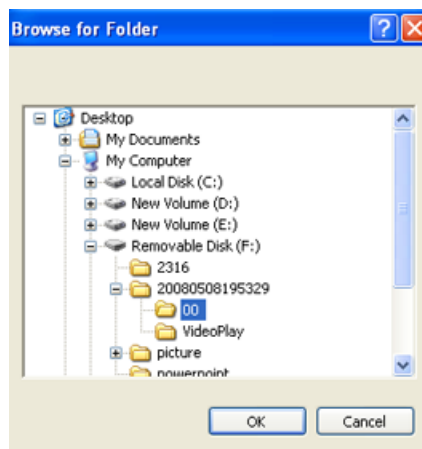
Remove the flash drive from the dvr & insert it into the computer.

Open My Computer, open the flash drive. Open the file player program. Use this to playback the video files.

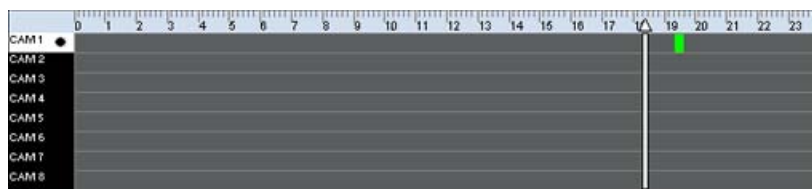


① Search Area ② Video Display Area ③ Video Data Area ④ Control Area ⑤ AVI converting

Click Browse to choose the folder which contains the video backup.

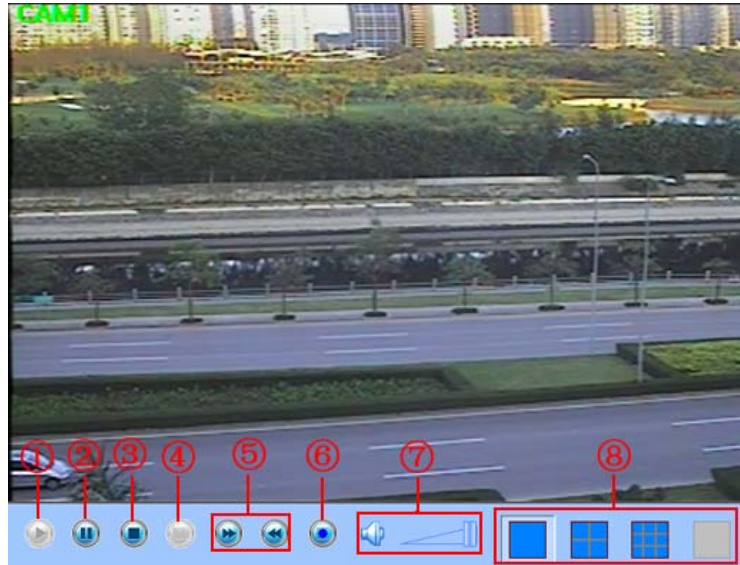


Set the date and channels. It will show the recorded video in area ③ with green at the top as shown below.



If using event search (for example, to search for motion events), it will list them at the bottom of area ①

Drag the slide bar to the start time point and click the play button to view.

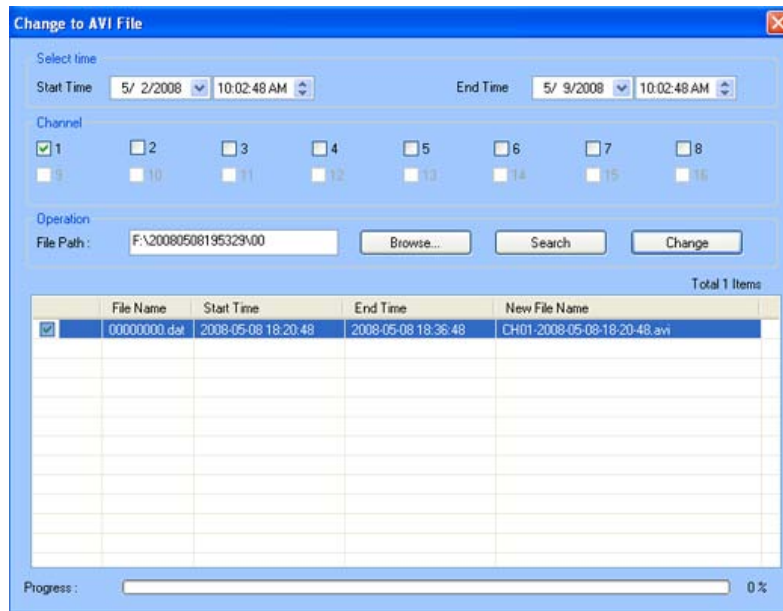
This program has a tool to convert the video backup files to an AVI format.

Click “Change File to AVI”. The converter will appear.

Click Browse to choose the folder which contains the video backup.

Set the start / end time, select the channels, and then the Click search button.

It will show video backup files in the file display area:



Select the files.

Click the Change button, it will start converting the files and show the progress at the bottom.

When the progress bar shows 100% it is finished.

Users can play the AVI files on Windows Media Player.
