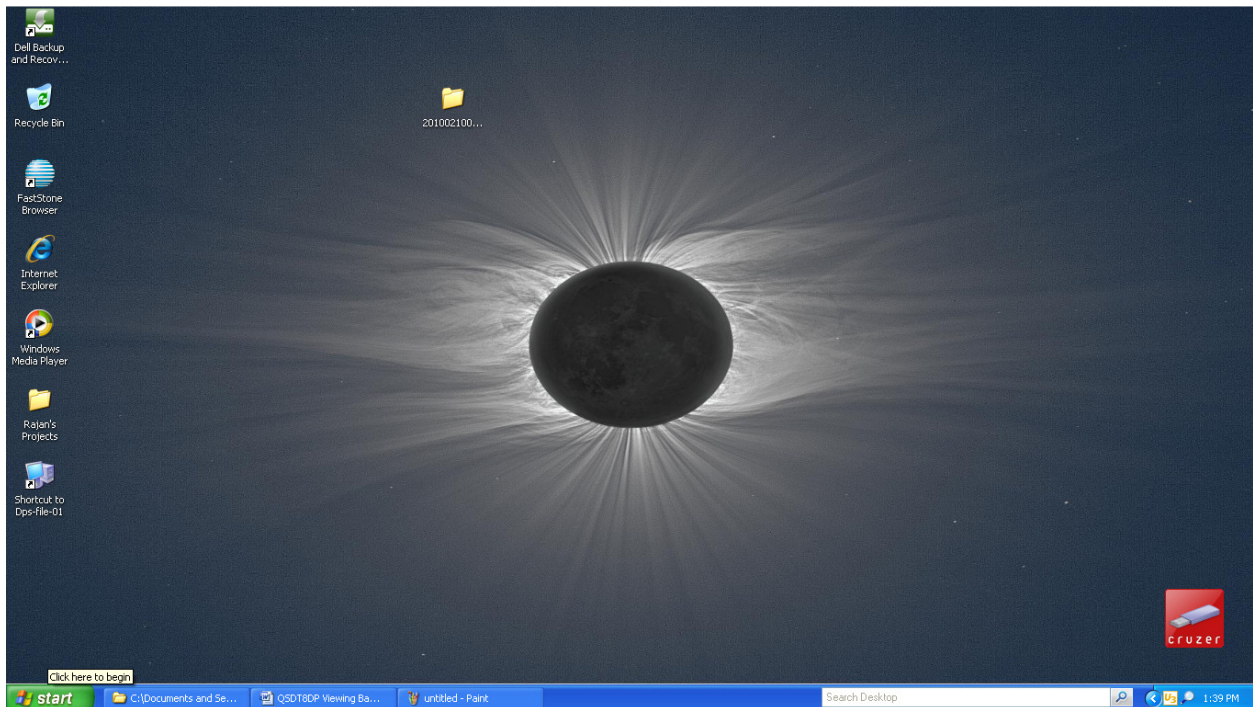
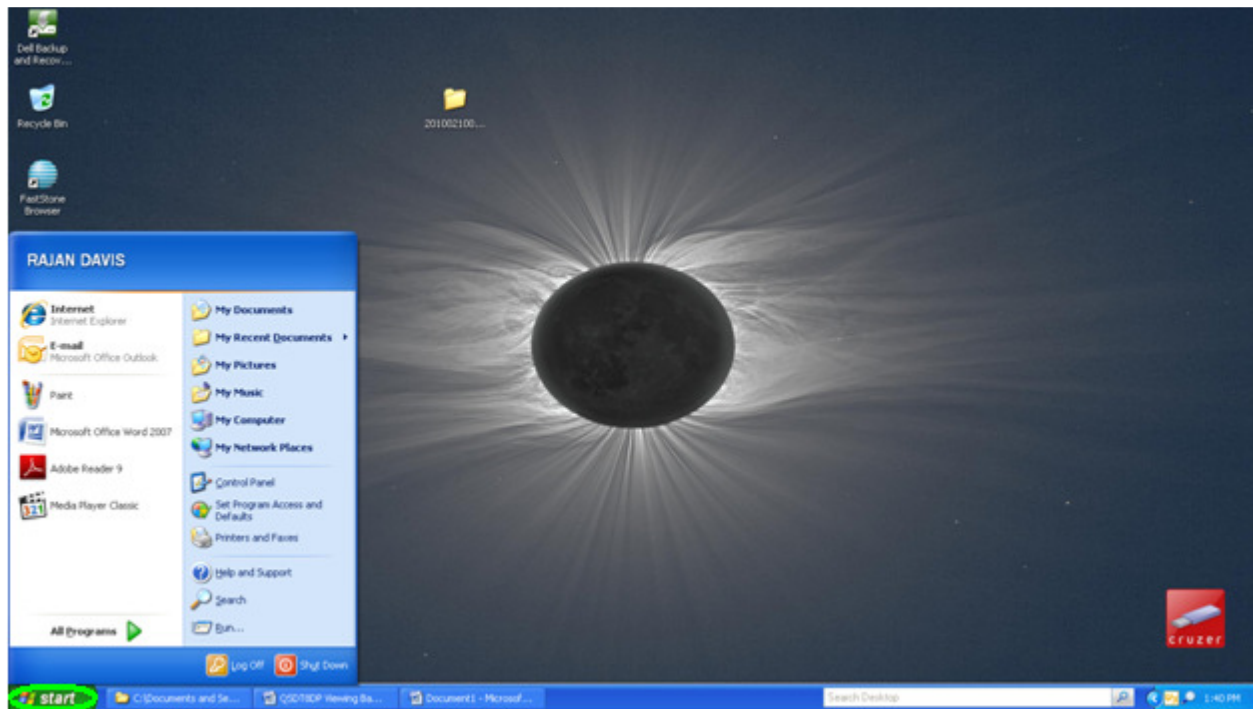


QSDT8DP Viewing Backed Up Videos

STEP 1: Turn on your computer and load up your desktop. Connect your flash drive to your computer.

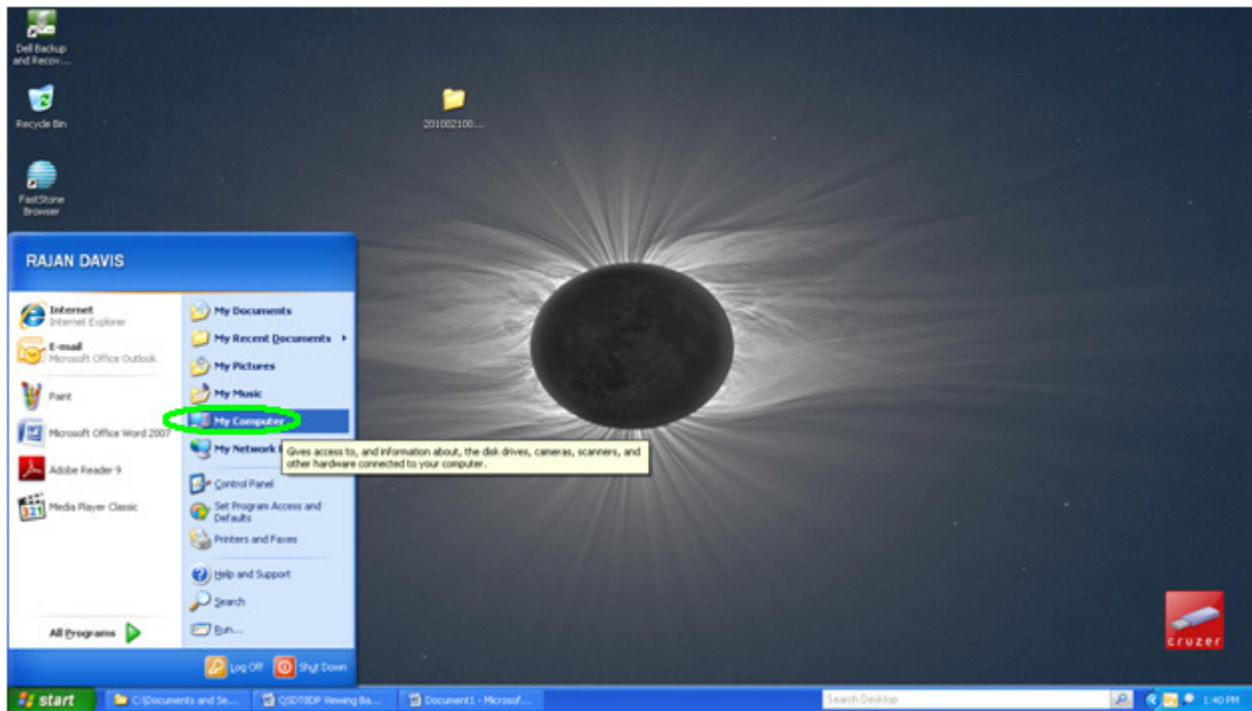


STEP 2: Click on the Start button.

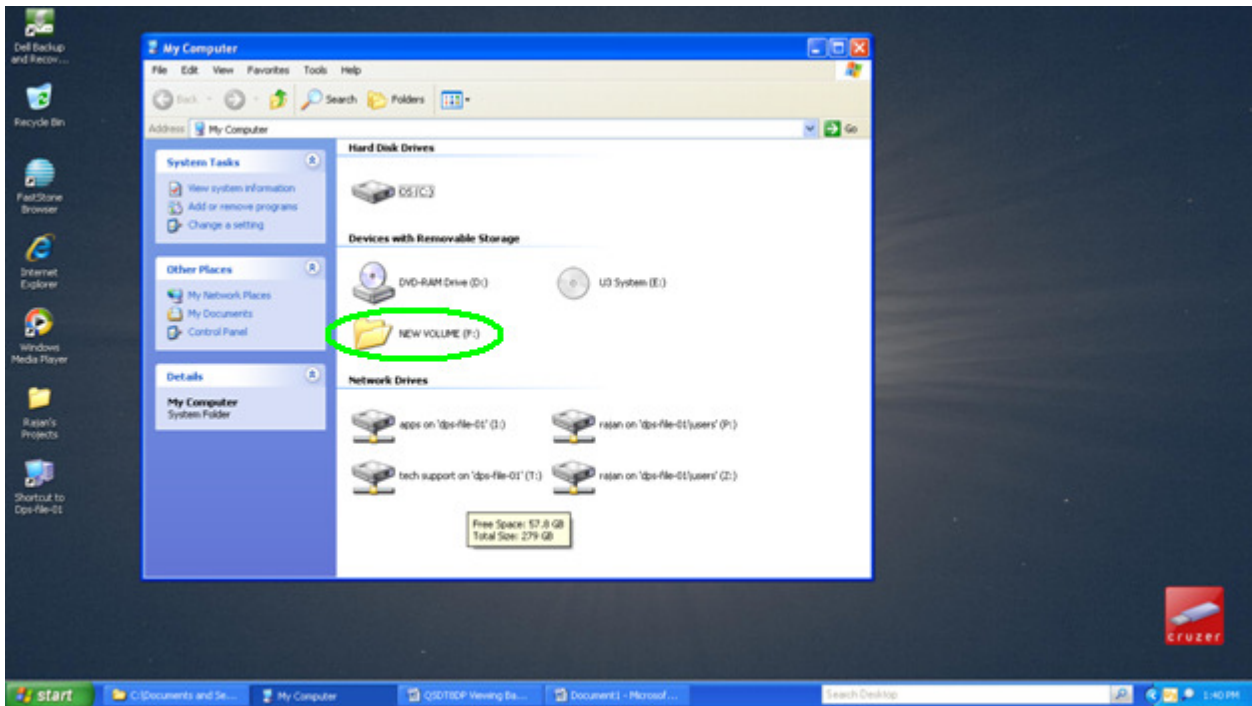

STEP 3: Move the cursor to “My Computer” and click on this folder.

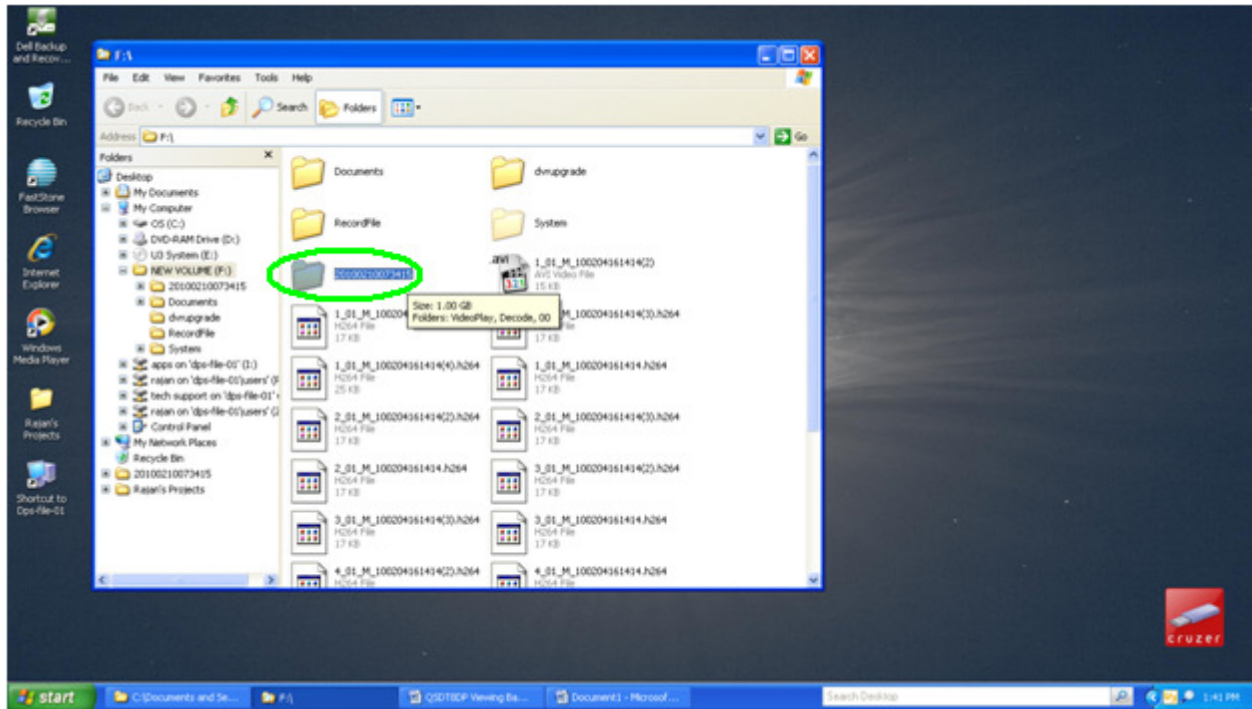


STEP 4: Go to the drive/folder associated to your flash drive.

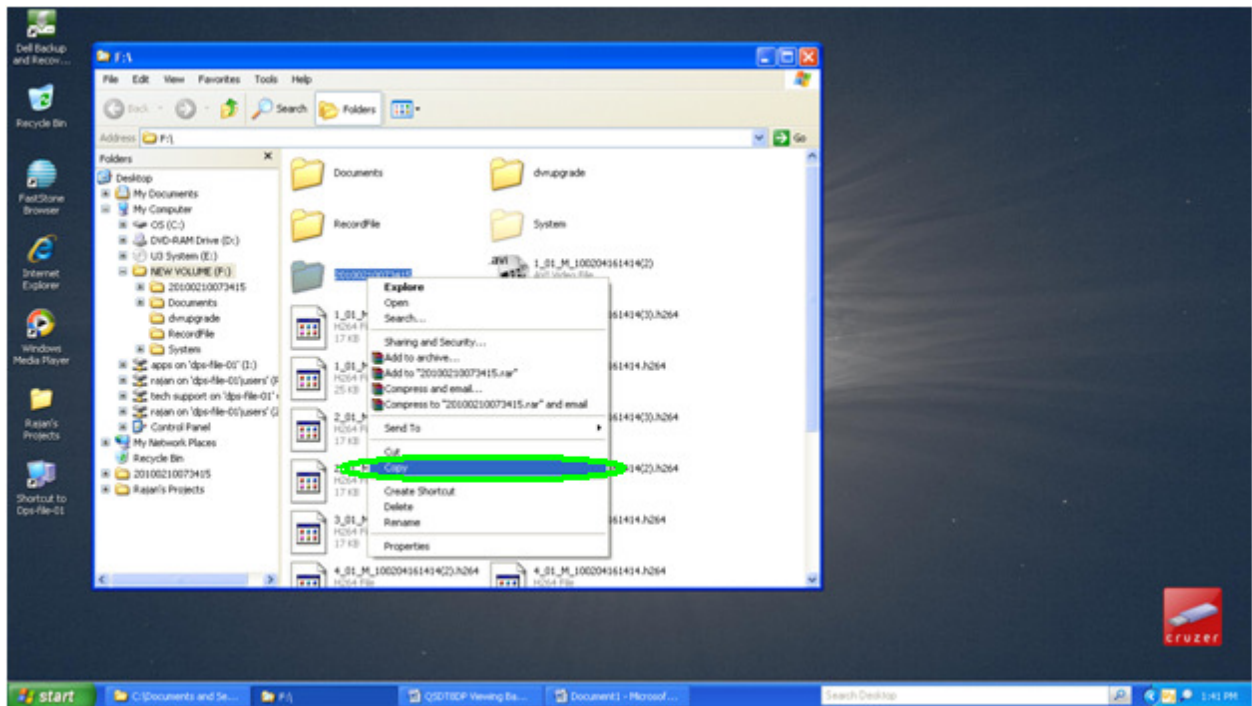

STEP 5: Find the folder that contains the backed up video files.

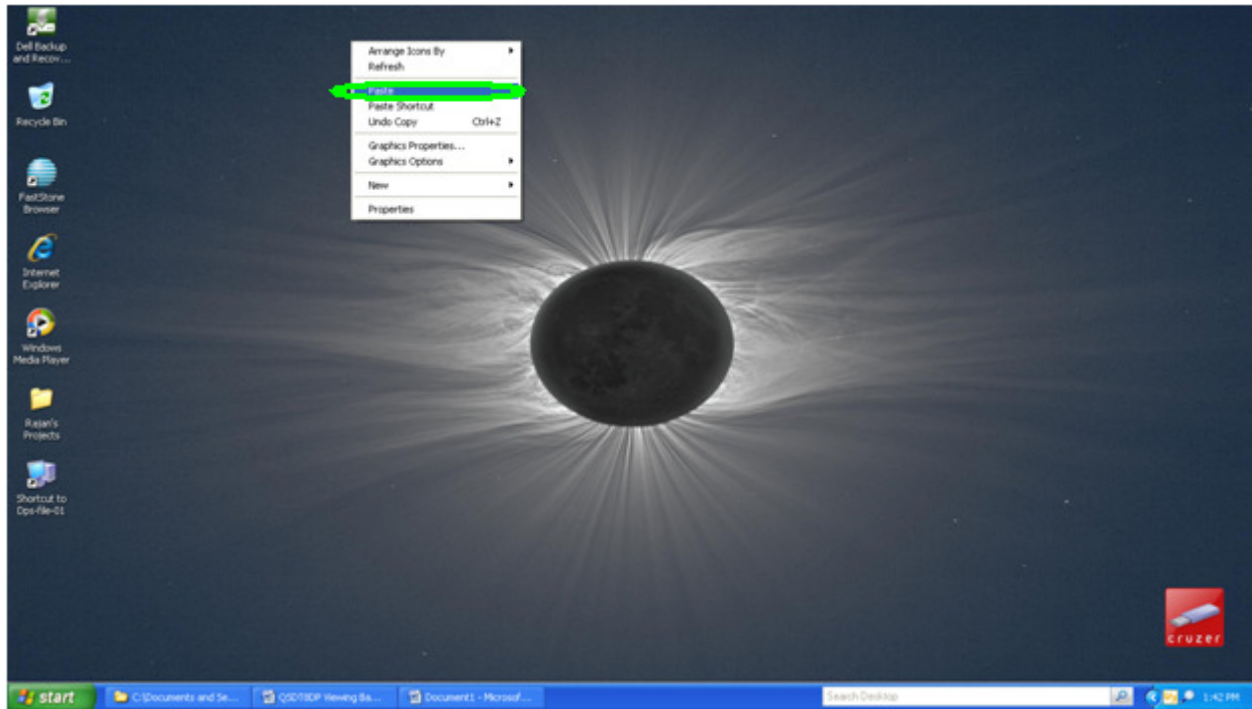


STEP 6: Right click on the folder that contains the backed up files and select “copy”.

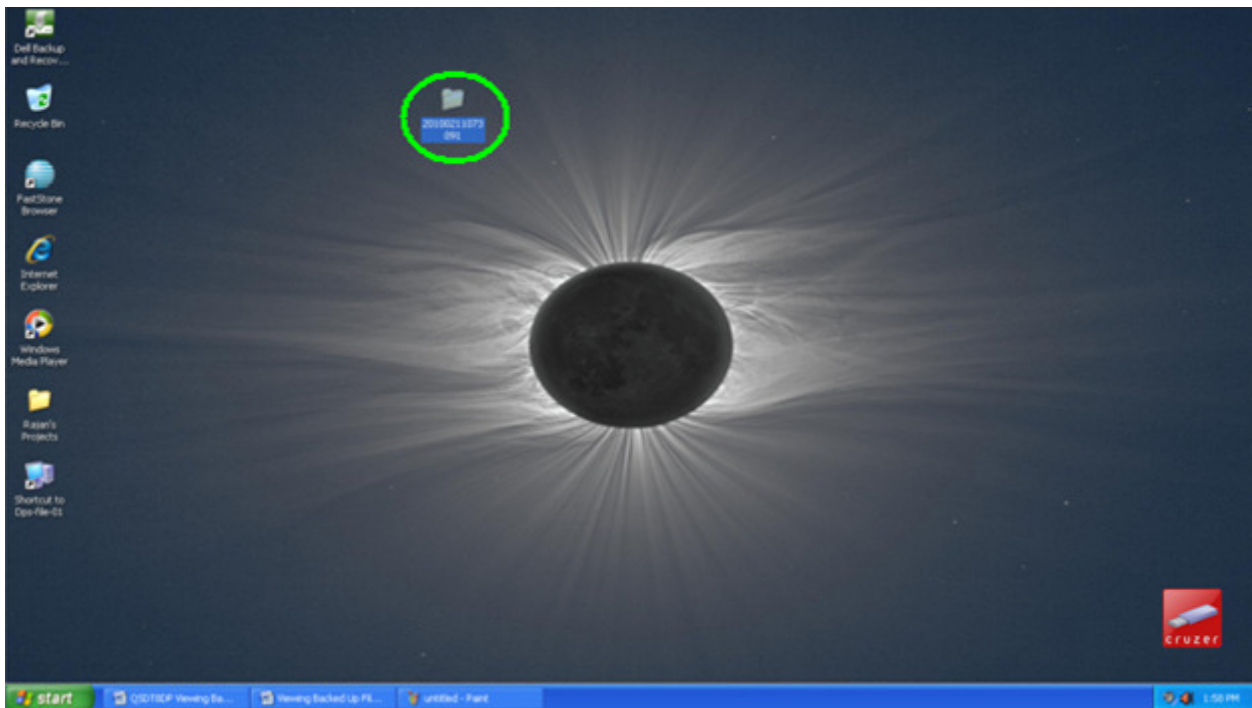

STEP 7: Right click and paste your folder in a place where you can find it later.

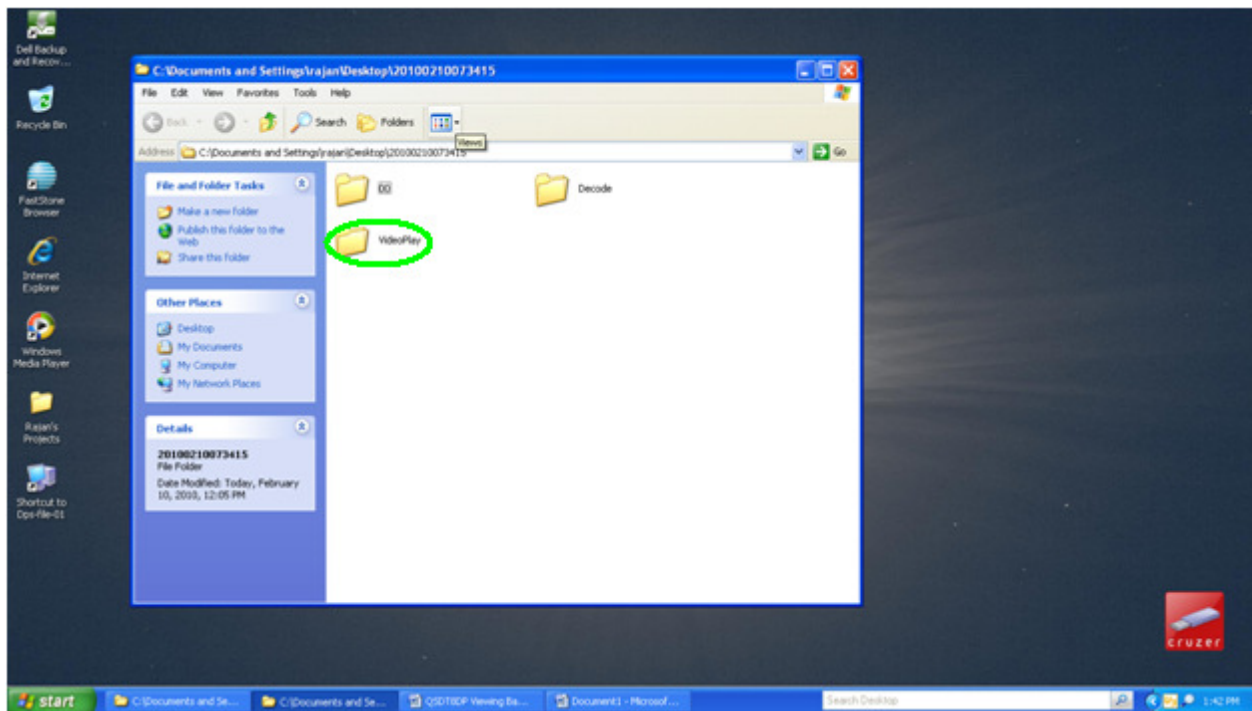


STEP 8: Find the folder that you copied from your flash drive.

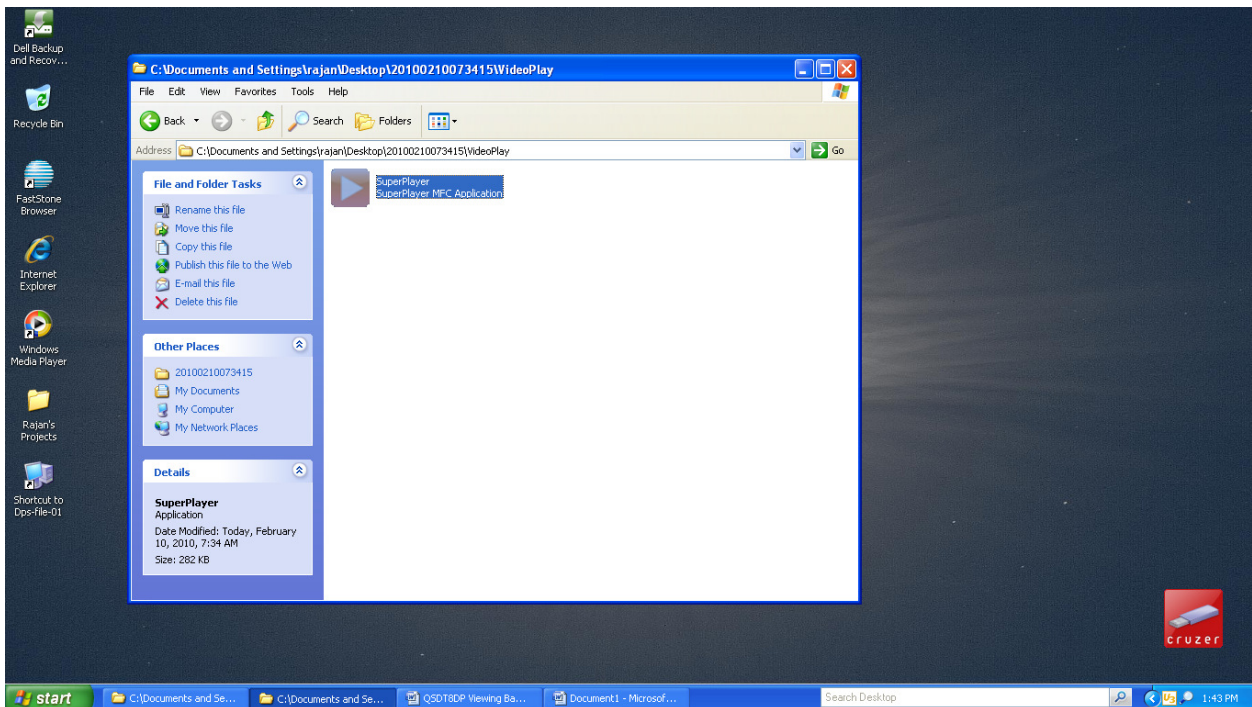

STEP 9: Open the copied folder. Open the folder entitled “Video Play” that is located inside the copied folder.

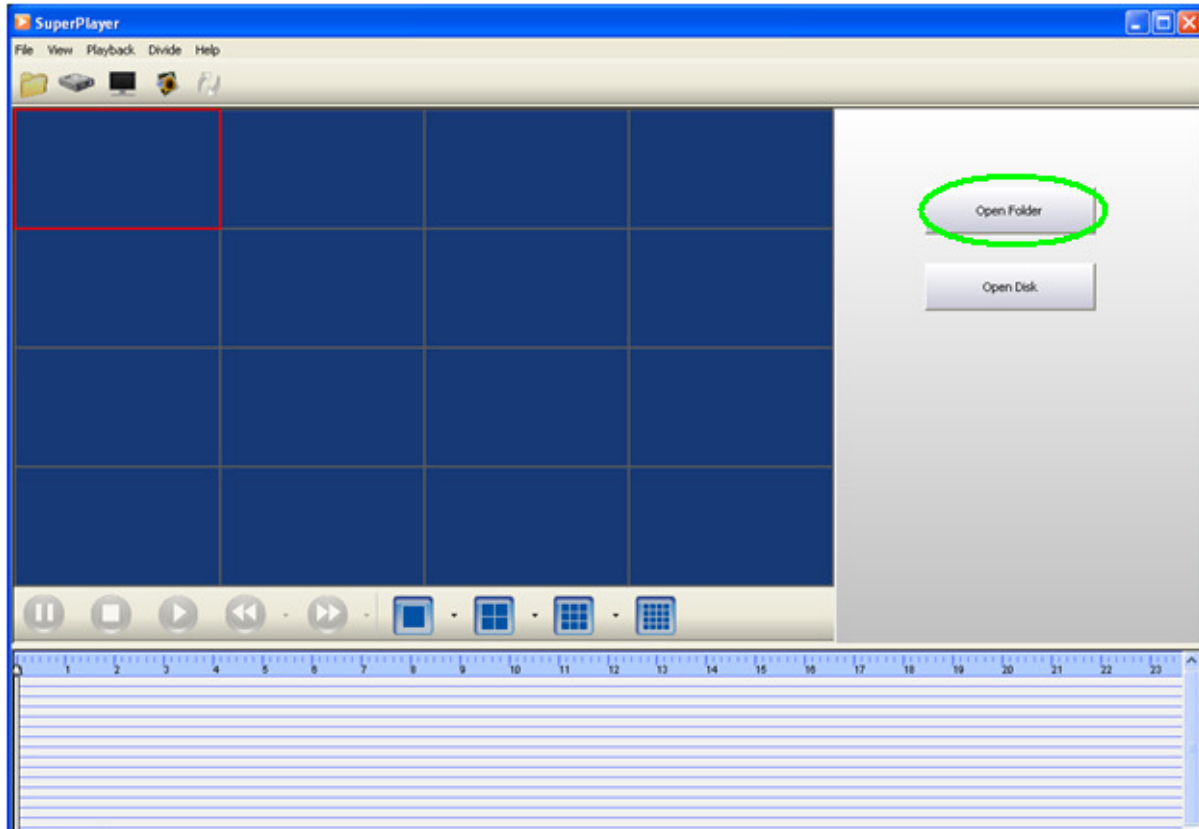


STEP 10: Open the Super Player application.

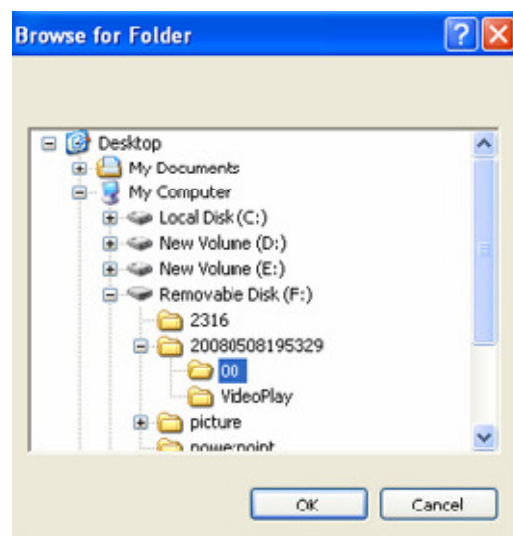
